**Psalm 121:1, 2** — 1 I will lift up mine eyes unto the hills, from  
whence cometh my help. 2 My help cometh from the LORD,  
which made heaven and earth.

**Psalm 23:1–3** — 1 The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.

2 He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters. 3 He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake.

**Jeremiah 17:7, 8** — 7 Blessed is the man that trusteth in the LORD, and whose hope the LORD is. 8 For he shall be as a tree planted by the waters, and that spreadeth out her roots by the river, and shall not see when heat cometh, but her leaf shall be green; and shall not be careful in the year of drought, neither shall cease from yielding fruit.

**Isaiah 48:18** — 18 O that thou hadst hearkened to my  
commandments! then had thy peace been as a river, and thy  
righteousness as the waves of the sea:

**Matthew 13:43** — 43 Then shall the righteous shine forth as the sun in the kingdom of their Father. . . .

**Isaiah 44:22** — 22 I have blotted out [wiped away], as a thick cloud, thy transgressions, and, as a cloud, thy sins: . . .

**Psalm 19:1-4** — 1 The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament sheweth his handywork. 2 Day unto day uttereth speech, and night unto night sheweth knowledge. 3 There is no speech nor language, where their voice is not heard. 4 Their line is gone out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world. In them hath he set a tabernacle for the sun,



**Genesis 15:5** — 5 And he brought him forth abroad, and said,  
*Look now toward heaven, and tell the stars, if thou be able to number them:*  
and he said unto him, So shall thy seed be.



**Psalm 147:4, 5** — 4 He telleth the number of the stars; he calleth them all by their names. 5 Great is our Lord, and of great power: his understanding is infinite.

**Isaiah 40:21, 22** — 21 Have ye not known? have ye not heard?  
hath it not been told you from the beginning? have ye not  
understood from the foundations of the earth? 22 It is he that  
sitteth upon the circle of the earth, and the inhabitants thereof are  
as grasshoppers; that stretcheth out the heavens as a curtain, and  
spreadeth them out as a tent to dwell in:

**Isaiah 40:15** — 15 Behold, the nations are as a drop of a bucket,  
and are counted as the small dust of the balance: behold, he taketh  
up the isles as a very little thing.

**Job 28:24** — 24 For he looketh to the ends of the earth, and seeth  
under the whole heaven;

**Psalm 8:1 (KJV)** — 1 O LORD our Lord, how excellent [noble, glorious, majestic] is thy name in all the earth! who hast set thy glory above the heavens.

**1 Peter 5:7** — 7 Casting all your care upon him; for he  
careth for you.



**Matthew 6:25, 26** — 25 Therefore I say unto you, Take no [not] thought for your life, what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink; nor yet for your body, what ye shall put on. Is not the life more than meat, and the body than raiment? 26 Behold the fowls of the air: for they sow not, neither do they reap, nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feedeth them. Are ye not much better than they?

**Matthew 6:28–30** — 28 And why take ye thought for raiment?

Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they toil not,

neither do they spin: 29 And yet I say unto you, That even

Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. 30

Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which to day

is, and to morrow is cast into the oven, shall he not much more

clothe you, O ye of little faith?

**Matthew 6:31** — 31 Therefore take no [not] thought, saying,  
What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal  
shall we be clothed?

**Matthew 6:33** — 33 But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and  
his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

**Psalm 42:5** — 5 Why art thou cast down, O my soul? and why art thou disquieted in me? hope thou in God: for I shall yet praise him for the help of his countenance.

**Psalm 42:7, 8** — 7 Deep calleth unto deep at the noise of thy waterspouts: all thy waves and thy billows are gone over me.

8 Yet the LORD will command his lovingkindness in the daytime, and in the night his song shall be with me, and my prayer unto the God of my life.

**Psalm 93:1–5 (ESV)** — 1 The LORD reigns; he is robed in majesty; the LORD is robed; he has put on strength as his belt.

Yes, the world is established; it shall never be moved. 2 Your throne is established from of old; you are from everlasting. 3 The floods have lifted up, O LORD, the floods have lifted up their voice; the floods lift up their roaring. 4 Mightier than the thunders of many waters, mightier than the waves of the sea, the LORD on high is mighty! 5 Your decrees are very trustworthy; holiness befits your house, O LORD, forevermore.

**Psalm 89:8, 9** — 8 O LORD God of hosts, Who is a strong  
LORD like unto thee? Or to thy faithfulness round about thee?  
9 Thou rulest the raging of the sea: When the waves thereof  
arise, thou stillest them.

**Psalm 89:13–15** — 13 Thou hast a mighty arm: Strong is thy hand, and high is thy right hand. 14 Justice [Heb.: *tsedeq*] and judgment are the habitation of thy throne: Mercy and truth shall go before thy face. 15 Blessed is the people that know the joyful sound: They shall walk, O LORD, in the light of thy countenance.



**Psalm 51:1-4** — 1 Have mercy upon me, O God, according to thy lovingkindness: According unto the multitude of thy tender mercies blot out my transgressions. 2 Wash me thoroughly from mine iniquity, And cleanse me from my sin. 3 For I acknowledge my transgressions: And my sin is ever before me. 4 Against thee, thee only, have I sinned, And done this evil in thy sight: That thou mightest be justified when thou speakest, And be clear when thou judgest.

**Psalm 51:6, 7** — 6 Behold, thou desirest truth in the inward parts: And in the hidden part thou shalt make me to know wisdom. 7 Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean: Wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow.

**Psalm 51:10–12** — 10 Create in me a clean heart, O God; And renew a right spirit within me. 11 Cast me not away from thy presence; And take not thy holy spirit from me. 12 Restore unto me the joy of thy salvation; And uphold me with thy free spirit.

**Isaiah 40:28–31** — 28 Hast thou not known? hast thou not heard, That the everlasting God, the LORD, The Creator of the ends of the earth, Fainteth not, neither is weary? There is no searching of his understanding. 29 He giveth power to the faint; And to them that have no might he increaseth strength. 30 Even the youths shall faint and be weary, And the young men shall utterly fall: 31 But they that wait [hope] upon the LORD shall renew their strength; They shall mount up with wings as eagles; They shall run, and not be weary; And they shall walk, and not faint.

**1 Chronicles 16:8, 9** — 8 Give thanks unto the LORD,  
call upon his name, Make known his deeds among the  
people. 9 Sing unto him, sing psalms unto him, Talk ye of  
all his wondrous works.

**Isaiah 12:2, 3** — 2 Behold, God is my salvation; I will trust, and not be afraid: For the Lord JEHOVAH is my strength and my song; He also is become my salvation.\*  
3 Therefore with joy shall ye draw water out of the wells of salvation.

**Isaiah 55:1 (KJV 1900)** — 1 Ho, every one that  
thirsteth, come ye to the waters, And he that hath no  
money; Come ye, buy, and eat; Yea, come, buy wine and  
milk without money and without price.

**Isaiah 58:11 (KJV 1900)** — 11 And the Lord shall guide thee continually, And satisfy thy soul in drought, And make fat thy bones: And thou shalt be like a watered garden, And like a spring of water, whose waters fail not.



**Psalm 36:8, 9 (KJV 1900)** — 8 They shall be abundantly satisfied with the fatness of thy house; And thou shalt make them drink of the river of thy pleasures. 9 For with thee is the fountain of life: In thy light shall we see light.

**John 4:13, 14** — 13 Jesus answered and said unto her,  
Whosoever drinketh of this water shall thirst again: 14 But  
whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall  
never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in  
him a well of water springing up into everlasting life.

**2 Corinthians 5:1** — 1 For we know that if our earthly house of this tabernacle were dissolved, we have a building of God, an house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens.

**2 Corinthians 5:17** — 17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

**Ezekiel 36:25–28** — 25 Then will I sprinkle clean water upon you, and ye shall be clean: from all your filthiness, and from all your idols, will I cleanse you. 26 A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh. 27 And I will put my spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes, and ye shall keep my judgments, and do them. 28 And ye shall dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers; and ye shall be my people, and I will be your God.

**2 Corinthians 3:17** — 17 Now the Lord is that Spirit: and  
where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty.

**Titus 3:5–7 (KJV 1900)** — 5 Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost; 6 Which he shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Saviour; 7 That being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life.

**Isaiah 45:6–8** — 6 . . . That there is none beside me. I am the LORD, and there is none else. 7 I form the light, and create darkness: I make peace, and create evil: I the LORD do all these things. 8 Drop down, ye heavens, from above, And let the skies pour down righteousness: Let the earth open, and let them bring forth salvation, And let righteousness spring up together; I the LORD have created it.



**Psalm 108:3, 4** — 3 I will praise thee, O LORD, among  
the people: And I will sing praises unto thee among the  
nations. 4 For thy mercy is great above the heavens: And thy  
truth reacheth unto the clouds.

**Psalm 103:8** — 8 The LORD is merciful and gracious,  
Slow to anger, and plenteous in mercy.

**Psalm 103:11, 12** — 11 For as the heaven is high above  
the earth, So great is his mercy toward them that fear him.

12 As far as the east is from the west, So far hath he  
removed our transgressions from us.

**Romans 8:38, 39** — 38 For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, 39 Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

**Isaiah 26:3, 4** — 3 Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace,  
Whose mind is stayed on thee: Because he trusteth in thee.

4 Trust ye in the LORD for ever: For in the LORD  
JEHOVAH is everlasting strength:

**Romans 1:20** — 20 For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; . . .

**Psalm 104:24** — 24 O Lord, how manifold are thy works! In wisdom hast thou made them all: The earth is full of thy riches.

**Psalm 104:31** — 31 The glory of the LORD shall endure for ever: The LORD shall rejoice in his works.



**Psalm 16:11** — 11 Thou wilt shew me the path of life:  
In thy presence is fulness of joy; At thy right hand there  
are pleasures for evermore.
