
El Salvador

The Saviour



- Smaller than Massachusetts, and is the smallest country in Central America
- Known as the land of volcanos—has more than 100 volcanos, with 20 potentially active
- Half of the people live in the countryside and may not have running water.
- Education is free up to the 9th grade, but many people cannot afford the cost of supplies and transportation.
- Rice, beans, and tortillas are the main foods. Avocados and mangoes are readily available.

- Coastline is about 190 miles
- > 19% of the population lives on \$1.25/day
- One of the most popular surfing destinations—big swells and long waves
- The Maya ruins at Tazumal are the most important archaeology site in El Salvador. The occupation of Tazumal took place around 1200 BC.
- The country has had a high crime threat, such as having the 2nd highest murder rate in the world in 2011, but the crime threat has dropped in recent years due to increased police patrols.
