Galatians 4:4, 5 (KJV) — 4 But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law, 5 To redeem them that were under the law, **that we might receive the adoption of sons.**

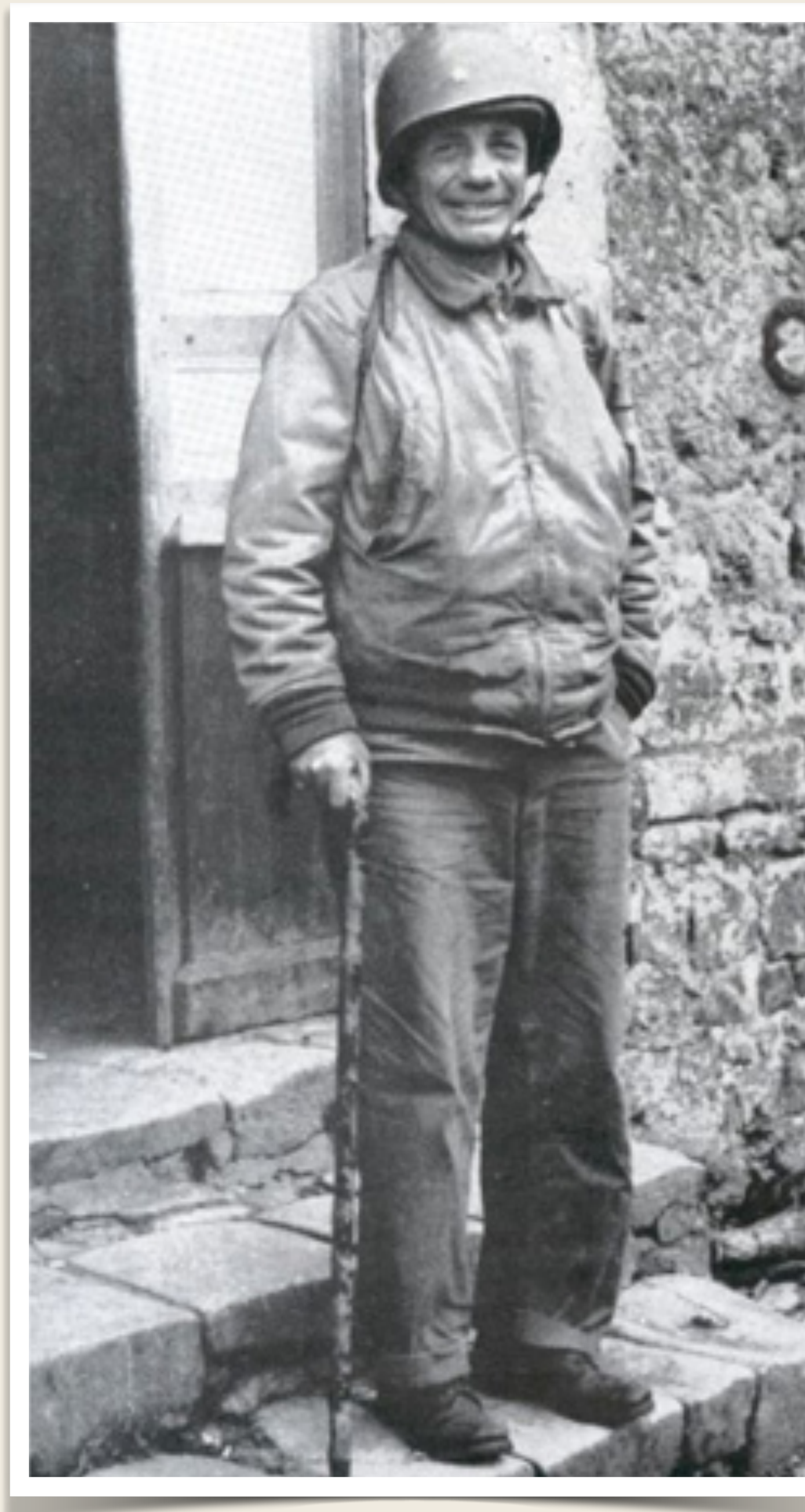
Galatians 4:7 (KJV) — 7 Wherefore thou **art no more a servant**
(δοῦλος – *doulos*), but a son; and if a son, then **an heir of God**
through Christ.

1 John 3:1, 2 (KJV) — 1 Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that **we should be called the sons of God:** therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew him not. 2 Beloved, **now are we the sons of God**, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.

Romans 8:14, 15 (KJV) — 14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God. 15 For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but **ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.**

Romans 8:16, 17 (KJV) — 16 The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: 17 And if **children, then heirs;** heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together.

Hebrews 2:11, 12 (KJV) — 11 For both he that sanctifieth and they who are sanctified are all of one: for which cause **he is not ashamed to call them brethren**, 12 Saying, I will declare thy name unto my brethren, in the midst of the church will I sing praise unto thee.

Ephesians 2:19 (KJV) — 19 Now therefore ye are
no more strangers and foreigners, but
**fellowcitizens with the saints, and of the
household of God;**

“Except a man be born again,”—unless he receive a new heart, new desires, purposes, and motives, leading to a new life—“he cannot see the kingdom of God.” He must no longer remain in subjection to the power of sin. He is no longer to be a willing subject to the enemy of Christ. **He is to become an heir of God by faith, a son of God by adoption.** (*Signs of the Times*, March 9, 1882, par. 14)

Ephesians 1:3–5 (KJV) — 3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ: 4 According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love: 5 **Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself**, according to the good pleasure of his will,

John 1:12, 13 (KJV) — 12 But as many as received him, to them **gave he power to become the sons of God**, even to them that believe on his name: 13 Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

Philippians 4:6 (KJV) — 6 Be careful for nothing; but
in every thing by prayer and supplication with
thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.

careful = μεριμνάω (*merimnaō*). To be
anxious or worry. Related is μέριμνα
(*merimna*) which is the noun form to
worry or be anxious.

*I am writing in haste to
prevent your being
anxious, for I will see
that you are not worried.*

Matthew 6:25 (KJV) — 25 Therefore I say unto you,
Take no thought (*merimnaō*) for your life, what ye shall
eat, or what ye shall drink; nor yet for your body, what ye
shall put on. Is not the life more than meat, and the body
than raiment?

1 Peter 5:7 (KJV) — 7 Casting all your **care** (*merimna*)
upon him; for he careth for you.
