

1 John 3:1, 2 (KJV) — 1 Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God: therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew him not. 2 Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.

Romans 8:14, 15 (KJV) — 14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God. 15 For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.

Romans 8:16, 17 (KJV) — 16 The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: 17 And if **children**, **then heirs**; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together.

Ephesians 2:19 (KJV) — 19 Now therefore ye are no more strangers and foreigners, but fellowcitizens with the saints, and of the household of God;



John 1:12, 13 (KJV) — 12 But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name: 13 Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

# Philippians 4:6 (KJV) — 6 Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.

careful = μεριμνάω (merimnaō). To be anxious or worry. Related is μέριμνα (merimna) which is the noun form to worry or be anxious.



**Matthew 6:25 (KJV)** — 25 Therefore I say unto you, **Take no thought** (*merimnaō*) for your life, what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink; nor yet for your body, what ye shall put on. Is not the life more than meat, and the body than raiment?

1 Peter 5:7 (KJV) — 7 Casting all your care (merimna) upon him; for he careth for you.
