
### The Father and Son Love each other:

1 John 4:8–10 (KJV) — 8 He that loveth not knoweth not God; for God is love. 9 In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him. 10 Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins.



### John 4:34 (KJV) — 34 Jesus saith unto them, My meat is to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work.

John 5:19 (KJV) — 19 Then answered Jesus and said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do: for what things soever he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise.

John 5:30 (KJV) — 30 I can of mine own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not mine own will, but the will of the Father which hath sent me.

When Jesus was awakened to meet the storm, He was in perfect peace. There was no trace of fear in word or look, for no fear was in His heart. But He rested not in the possession of almighty power. It was not as the "Master of earth and sea and sky" that He reposed in quiet.

That power He had laid down, and He says, "I can of Mine own self do nothing." John 5:30. He trusted in the Father's might. It was in faith—faith in God's love and care—that Jesus rested, and the power of that word which stilled the storm was the power of God. (The Desire of Ages, p. 336.1)

### John 6:38 (KJV) — 38 For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me.

John 17:7–8 (KJV) — 7 Now they have known that all things whatsoever thou hast given me are of thee. 8 For I have given unto them the words which thou gavest me; and they have received them, and have known surely that I came out from thee, and they have believed that thou didst send me.

### John 7:16 (KJV) — 16 Jesus answered them, and said, My doctrine is not mine, but his that sent me.

The priests and rabbis were taking the Son of God to task for the very work He had been sent into the world to do. By their sins they had separated themselves from God, and in their pride were moving independently of Him. They felt sufficient in themselves for all things, and realized no need of a higher wisdom to direct their acts.

But the Son of God was surrendered to the Father's will, and dependent upon His power. So utterly was Christ emptied of self that He made no plans for Himself. He accepted God's plans for Him, and day by day the Father unfolded His plans. So should we depend upon God, that our lives may be the simple outworking of His will. (The Desire of Ages, p. 208.2)



### John 8:29 (KJV) -29 And he that sent me is with me: the Father hath not left me alone; for I do always those things that please him.

### John 10:17 (KJV) — 17 Therefore doth my Father love me, because I lay down my life, that I might take it again.

## John 10:38 (KJV) — 38 But if I do, though ye believe not me, believe the works: that ye may know, and believe, that the Father is in

me, and I in him.

### John 11:42 (KJV) — 42 And I knew that thou hearest me always: but because of the people which stand by I said it, that they may believe that thou hast sent me.

John 17:21 (KJV) -21 That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me.

2 Corinthians 5:17 (KJV) — 17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old






