

Galatians 3:1 (KJV) — 1 O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, crucified among you?

Matthew 5:48 (KJV) — 48 Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect.

Galatians 5:19-21 (KJV) — 19 Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, 20 Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, 21 Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.

John 15:8 (KJV) — 8 Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be my disciples.

Matthew 5:16 (KJV) — 16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.
