

THE FINAL JUDGMENT

When the Son of man shall come in his glory, and all the holy with him, then shall he sit upon the throne of his glory, And before him shall be gathered all nations: and he shall separate them one from another, And he shall set the sheep on his right hand, but the goats on the left. -Matthew 25:31-33

Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand,
Come, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom
prepared for you from the foundation of the world: For
I was an hungred, and ye gave me meat: I was thirsty,
and ye gave me drink: I was a stranger, and ye took me
in: -Matthew 25:34-35

Naked, and ye clothed me: I was sick, and ye visited me: I was in prison, and ye came unto me. Or when saw we thee sick, or in prison, and came unto thee? Then shall the righteous answer him, saying, Lord, when saw we thee an hungred, and fed thee? or thirsty, and gave thee drink? --Matthew 25:36-37

Then shall they also answer him, saying, Lord, when saw we thee an hungred, or athirst, or a stranger, or naked, or sick, or in prison, and did not minister unto thee? Then shall he answer them, saying, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye did it not to one of the least of these, ye did it not to me. And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal. -Matthew 25:31-46

Then shall the righteous answer him, saying,
Lord, when saw we thee an hungred, and fed
thee? or thirsty, and gave thee drink? When
saw we thee a stranger, and took thee in? or
naked, and Clothed thee? Or when saw we thee
sick, or in prison, and came unto thee? -

Matthew 25:37-39

And the King shall answer and say unto them,
Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye have done it
unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have
done it unto me. Then shall he say also unto them
on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into
everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his
angels:

-Matthew 25:40-41

For I was an hungred, and ye gave me no meat: I was thirsty, and ye gave me no drink: -I was a stranger, and ye took me not in: naked, and ye clothed me not: sick, and in prison, and ye visited me not. -Then shall they also answer him, saying, Lord, when saw we thee an hungred, or athirst, or a stranger, or naked, or sick, or in prison, and did not minister unto thee? -Matthew 25:42-44

Then shall he answer them, saying, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye did it not to one of the least of these, ye did it not to me. -And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal. -Matthew 25:45-46

Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might. Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. -Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. -Ephesians 6:10-11

For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; -Ephesians 6:12-14

And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. -And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God: Ephesians 6:15-17

Yea, and all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution. But evil men and seducers shall wax worse and worse, deceiving, and being deceived.

-2 Timothy 3:12-13

So shall it be at the end of the world: the angels shall
come forth, and sever the wicked from among the just,
-Matthew 13:49

Finally, brethren, pray for us, that the word of the Lord may have free course, and be glorified, even as it is with you: And that we may be delivered from unreasonable and wicked men: for all men have not faith. But the Lord is faithful, who shall stablish you, and keep you from evil. we have confidence in the Lord touching you, that ye both do and do the things which we command you. And the Lord direct your hearts into the love of God, and into the patient waiting for Christ.

2 Thessalonians 3:1-5

We know that whosoever is born of God sinneth not;
but he that is begotten of God keepeth himself, and
that wicked one toucheth him not . we know that we
are of God, and the whole world lieth in wickedness.

Take heed, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief, in departing from the living God. But exhort one another daily, while it is called To day; lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin. For we are made partakers of Christ, if we hold the beginning of our confidence stedfast unto the end; -Hebrews 3:12-14

He that receiveth a prophet in the name of a prophet shall receive a prophet's reward; and he that receiveth a righteous man in the name of a righteous man shall receive a righteous man's reward. -And whosoever shall give to drink unto one of these little ones a cup of cold water only in the name of a disciple, verily I say unto you, he shall in no wise lose his reward. -Matthew 10:40-42
