

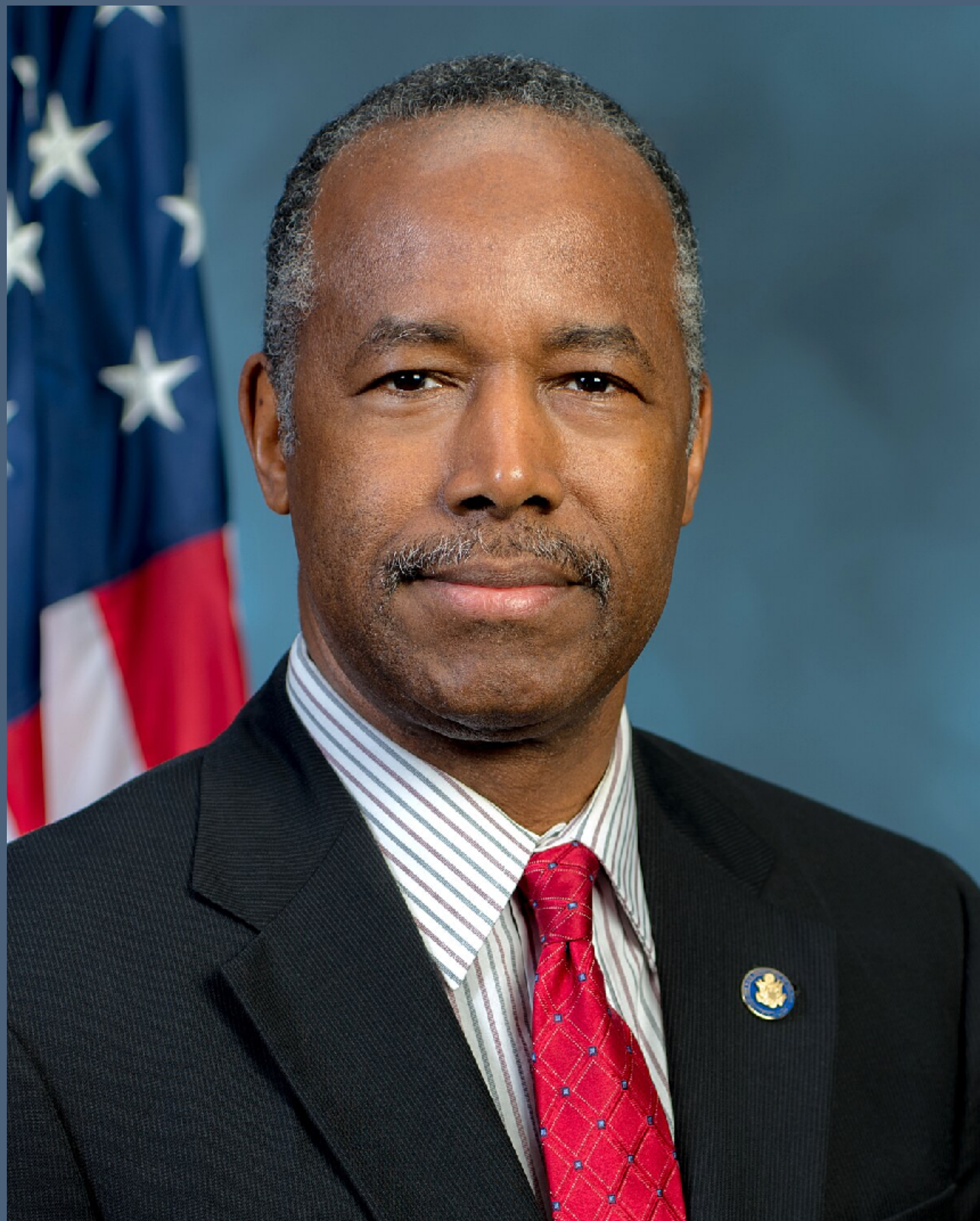
Dancing with the Devil

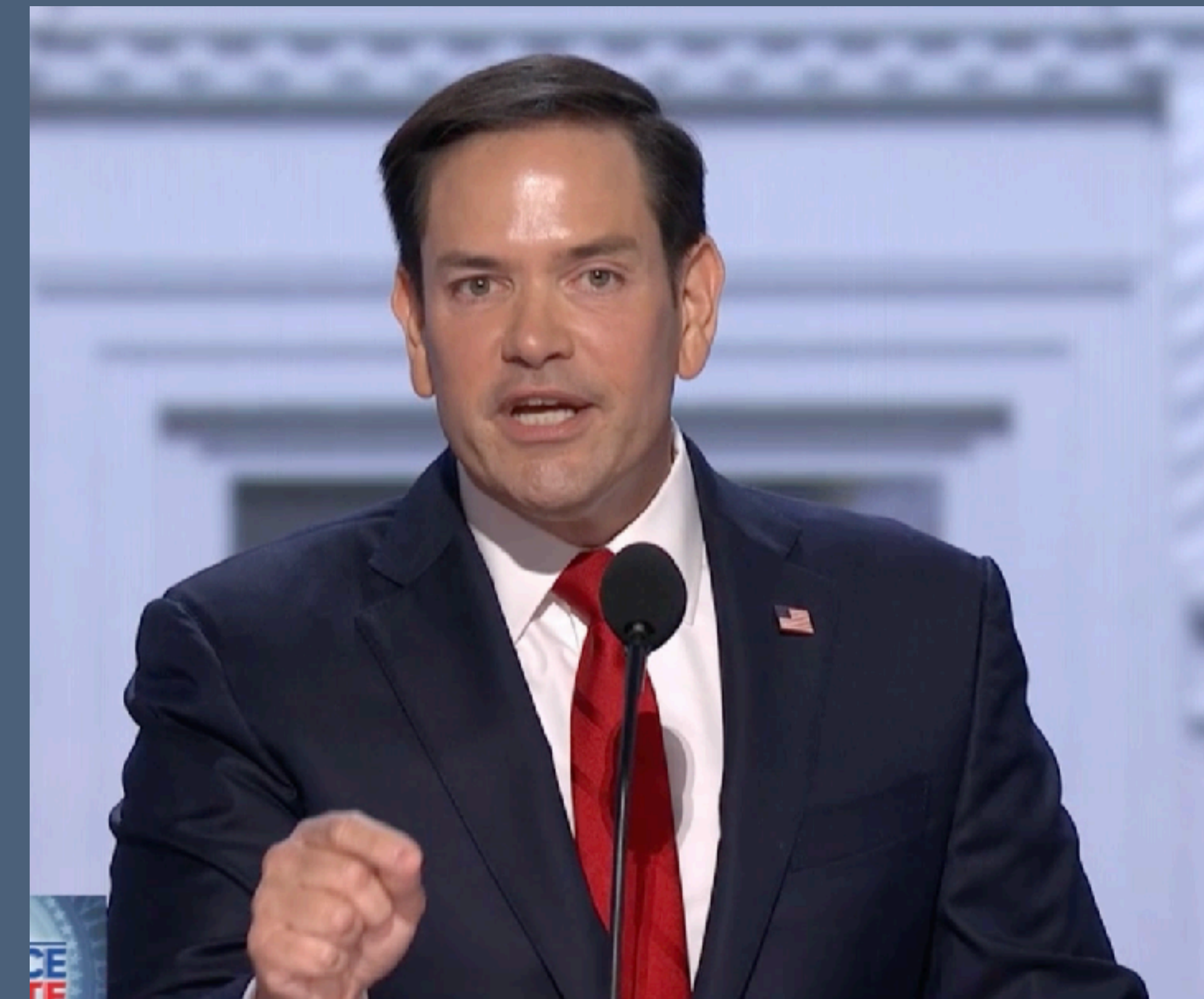
