
The anointed ones standing by the Lord of the whole earth, have the position once given to Satan as covering cherub. By the holy beings surrounding his throne, the Lord keeps up a constant communication with the inhabitants of the earth. The golden oil represents the grace with which God keeps the lamps of believers supplied, that they shall not flicker and go out. Were it not that this holy oil is poured from heaven in the messages of God's Spirit, the agencies of evil would have entire control over men. {RH, July 20, 1897 par. 6}







The Spirit = the Mind



"It is through the word that Christ abides in His followers. This is the same vital union that is represented by eating His flesh and drinking His blood. The words of Christ are spirit and life. Receiving them, you receive the life of the Vine. You live "by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God." Matt. 4:4. The life of Christ in you produces the same fruits as in Him. Living in Christ, adhering to Christ, supported by Christ, drawing nourishment from Christ, you bear fruit after the similitude of Christ." DA 677.

Christ in us = the Spirit in us

That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by **his Spirit** in the inner man; that **Christ may dwell** in your hearts by faith . . . Ephesians 3:16-17

Spirit = non bodily presence of God or Christ

- Ps 139:7 Whither shall I go from thy spirit? or whither shall I flee from thy presence?
- Ps 51:11 Cast me not away from thy presence; and take not thy holy spirit from me.

Christ can see and hear and act in spirit, while physically at a distance.

 Ps 139:2 Thou knowest my downsitting and mine uprising, thou understandest my thought afar off.

Holy Spirit is the omnipresence of Spirit of Christ

This refers to the **omnipresence of the Spirit of Christ, called the Comforter**. Again Jesus says, "I have yet many things to say unto you, but ye cannot bear them now. Howbeit when He, the Spirit of truth is come, He will guide you into all truth" [John 16:12, 13]. {14MR 179.2}

Christ Abides in Us Through His Word

"God himself speaks to the believing, trusting soul; for **God's Spirit is in his word**,... It is thus that the believer eats of Christ, the Bread of Life. Truth is seen in a new light, and the soul rejoices as in the visible presence of Christ. {ST, October 10, 1895 par. 9}

7 Spirits

 And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth. (Revelation of John 5:6, KJV)

7 Spirits

- And out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thunderings and voices: and there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God. (Revelation of John 4:5)
