

2 Timothy 1:9–10 (KJV) — 9 Who hath saved us, and called us with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began, 10 But is now made manifest by the appearing of our Saviour Jesus Christ, who hath abolished death, and hath brought life and immortality to light through the gospel:

Luke 2:49 (KJV) — 49 And he said unto them,
How is it that ye sought me? wist ye not that I must
be about my Father's business?

With most of the people in the days of Christ, the observance of this feast had degenerated into formalism. But what was its significance to the Son of God! (*The Desire of Ages*, p. 77.2)

For the first time the child Jesus looked upon the temple. He saw the white-robed priests performing their solemn ministry. He beheld the bleeding victim upon the altar of sacrifice. With the worshipers He bowed in prayer, while the cloud of incense ascended before God. He witnessed the impressive rites of the paschal service. Day by day He saw their meaning more clearly. Every act seemed to be bound up with His own life. New impulses were awakening within Him. Silent and absorbed, He seemed to be studying out a great problem. The mystery of His mission was opening to the Saviour. (*The Desire of Ages*, p. 78.1)

In the answer to His mother, Jesus showed for the first time that He understood His relation to God.

(The Desire of Ages, p. 81.6)

John 4:34 (KJV) — 34 Jesus saith unto them, My meat is to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work.



John 6:38 (KJV) — 38 For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me.

Love for God, zeal for His glory, and love for fallen humanity, brought Jesus to earth to suffer and to die. This was the controlling power of His life. This principle He bids us adopt. (*The Desire of Ages*, p. 329.3)

Romans 5:10 (KJV) — 10 For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by his life.

Isaiah 59:2 (KJV) — 2 But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear.

1 Corinthians 15:3 (KJV) — 3 For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures;

John 8:46 (KJV) — 46 Which of you convinceth me of sin? And if I say the truth, why do ye not believe me?

Matthew 5:48 (KJV) — 48 Be ye therefore perfect,
even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect.

1 Peter 2:21–22 (KJV) — 21 For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps: 22 Who did no sin, neither was guile found in his mouth:

John 8:29 (KJV) — 29 And he that sent me is with me: the Father hath not left me alone; for I do always those things that please him.

John 1:29 (KJV) — 29 The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.

John 1:36 (KJV) — 36 And looking upon Jesus as he walked, he saith, Behold the Lamb of God!

Isaiah 53:7 (KJV) — 7 He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth.

1 Timothy 6:14–16 (KJV) — 14 That thou keep this commandment without spot, unrebukeable, until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ: 15 Which in his times he shall shew, who is the blessed and only Potentate, the King of kings, and Lord of lords; 16 Who only hath immortality, dwelling in the light which no man can approach unto; whom no man hath seen, nor can see: to whom be honour and power everlasting. Amen.

John 17:4 (KJV) — 4 I have glorified thee on the earth: I have finished the work which thou gavest me to do.

Leviticus 4:23 (KJV) — 23 Or if his sin, wherein he hath sinned, come to his knowledge; he shall bring his offering, a kid of the goats, a male without blemish:

Revelation 5:1–3 (KJV) — 1 And I saw in the right hand of him that sat on the throne a book written within and on the backside, sealed with seven seals. 2 And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, Who is worthy to open the book, and to loose the seals thereof? 3 And no man in heaven, nor in earth, neither under the earth, was able to open the book, neither to look thereon.

Revelation 5:4–7 (KJV) — 4 And I wept much, because no man was found worthy to open and to read the book, neither to look thereon. 5 And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Juda, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof. 6 And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth. 7 And he came and took the book out of the right hand of him that sat upon the throne.
