
**The 2,300 days and
“the hour of his judgment”**

Psalm 77:13 (KJV) — 13 Thy way, O God, is in the
sanctuary: who is so great a God as our God?

Daniel 8:14 (KJV) — 14 And he said unto me,
Unto two thousand and three hundred days
(Hebrew:evenings and mornings); then shall the
sanctuary be cleansed (צִדֵּק *tsadeq*).

Leviticus 16:30 (KJV) — 30 For on that day shall the priest make an atonement for you, to cleanse (טָהַר *taher*) you, that ye may be clean (טָהַר *taher*) from all your sins before the LORD.

Job 4:17 (KJV) — 17 Shall mortal man be more
just (צִדֵּק *tsadeq*) than *God*? shall a man be more
pure (טָהוֹר *taher*) than his *maker*?



Daniel 8:1-2 (KJV) — 1 In the third year (553BC) of the reign of king Belshazzar a *vision* (**chazon**) appeared unto me, even unto me Daniel, after that which appeared unto me at the first. 2 And I saw in a vision; and it came to pass, when I saw, that I was at Shushan in the palace, which is in the province of Elam; and I saw in a vision, and I was by the river of Ulai.

Daniel 8:3 (KJV) — 3 Then I lifted up mine eyes,
and saw, and, behold, there stood before the river a
ram which had two horns: and the two horns were
high; but one was higher than the other, and the
higher came up last.

Daniel 8:4-5 (KJV) — 4 I saw the ram pushing westward, and northward, and southward; so that no beasts might stand before him, neither was there any that could deliver out of his hand; but he did according to his will, and became **great**. 5 And as I was considering, behold, an he goat came from the west on the face of the whole earth, and touched not the ground: and the goat had a notable horn between his eyes.

Daniel 8:6-7 (KJV) — 6 And he came to the ram that had two horns, which I had seen standing before the river, and ran unto him in the fury of his power. 7 And I saw him come close unto the ram, and he was moved with choler against him, and smote the ram, and brake his two horns: and there was no power in the ram to stand before him, but he cast him down to the ground, and stamped upon him: and there was none that could deliver the ram out of his hand.

Daniel 8:8–9 (KJV) — 8 Therefore the he goat waxed **very great**: and when he was strong, the great horn was broken; and for it came up four notable ones toward the four winds of heaven.

9 And out of one of them came forth a little horn, which waxed **exceeding great**, toward the south, and toward the east, and toward the pleasant land.

Daniel 8:10–11 (KJV) — 10 And it waxed great, even to the host of heaven; and it cast down some of the host and of the stars to the ground, and stamped upon them. 11 Yea, he magnified himself even to the prince of the host, and by him the daily *sacrifice* was taken away, and the place of his sanctuary was cast down.

Daniel 8:12 (KJV) — 12 And an host was given him against the daily *sacrifice* by reason of transgression, and it cast down the truth to the ground; and it practised, and prospered.



Daniel 8:20–21 (KJV) — 20 The ram which thou sawest having two horns are the kings of Media and Persia. 21 And the rough goat is the king of Grecia: and the great horn that is between his eyes is the first king.

Daniel 8:22 (KJV) — 22 Now that being broken,
whereas four stood up for it, four kingdoms shall
stand up out of the nation, but not in his power.

Daniel 8:23-24 (KJV) — 23 And in the latter time of their kingdom, when the transgressors are come to the full, a king of fierce countenance, and understanding dark sentences, shall stand up.

24 And his power shall be mighty, but not by his own power: and he shall destroy wonderfully, and shall prosper, and practise, and shall destroy the mighty and the holy people.

Daniel 8:25 (KJV) — 25 And through his policy also he shall cause craft to prosper in his hand; and he shall magnify himself in his heart, and by peace shall destroy many: he shall also stand up against the Prince of princes; but he shall be broken without hand.

Daniel 8:19 (KJV) — 19 And he said, Behold, I will make thee know what shall be in the last end of the indignation: for at the time appointed the end shall be.

Daniel 8:26–27 (KJV) — 26 And the vision
(**mareh**) of the evening and the morning which
was told is true: wherefore shut thou up the vision;
for it shall be for many days. 27 And I Daniel
fainted, and was sick certain days; afterward I rose
up, and did the king's business; and I was
astonished at the vision (**chazon**), but none
understood it.

**Daniel 9:1 (KJV) — 1 In the first year (538 BC,
15 years after the vision of chapter 8) of
Darius the son of Ahasuerus, of the seed of the
Medes, which was made king over the realm of
the Chaldeans;**

Daniel 9:2-3 (KJV) — 2 In the first year of his reign I Daniel understood by books the number of the years, whereof the word of the LORD came to Jeremiah the prophet, that he would accomplish seventy years in the desolations of Jerusalem.

3 And I set my face unto the Lord God, to seek by prayer and supplications, with fasting, and sackcloth, and ashes:

Daniel 9:20 (KJV) — 20 And whiles I was speaking, and praying, and confessing my sin and the sin of my people Israel, and presenting my supplication before the LORD my God for the holy mountain of my God;

Daniel 9:21 (KJV) — 21 Yea, whiles I was speaking in prayer, even the man Gabriel, whom I had seen in the vision (**chazon**) at the beginning, being caused to fly swiftly, touched me about the time of the evening oblation.

Daniel 9:22 (KJV) — 22 And he informed me,
and talked with me, and said, O Daniel, I am now
come forth to give thee skill and understanding.

Daniel 9:23 (KJV) — 23 At the beginning of thy supplications the commandment came forth, and I am come to shew thee; for thou art greatly beloved: therefore understand the matter, and consider the vision (**mareh**).

Daniel 8:1 (KJV) — 1 In the third year of the
reign of king Belshazzar a *vision* (**chazon**)
appeared unto me, even unto me Daniel, after that
which appeared unto me at the first.

Daniel 8:27 (KJV) — 27 And I Daniel fainted, and was sick certain days; afterward I rose up, and did the king's business; and I was astonished at the vision **(mareh)**, but none understood it.

Daniel 9:23 (KJV) — 23 At the beginning of thy supplications the commandment came forth, and I am come to shew thee; for thou art greatly beloved: therefore understand the matter, and consider the vision (**mareh**).

Daniel 9:24 (KJV) — 24 Seventy weeks are determined (Heb. Divide or cut off from) upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision **(chazon)** and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy.


Daniel 9:25 (KJV) — 25 Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the Messiah the Prince shall be seven weeks, and threescore and two weeks: the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublous times.

Daniel 9:26 (KJV)— 26 And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself: and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary; and the end thereof shall be with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined.

Daniel 9:27 (KJV) — 27 And he shall confirm the covenant with many for one week: and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make it desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate.

Seventy weeks, have been **divided** concerning thy
people and concerning thy holy city.

The only part of the **chazon**, (Daniel 8:1) not understood was the **mareh**.


Daniel was astonished at the **mareh** (Daniel 8:27)

Ezra 7:7 (KJV) — 7 And there went up some of the children of Israel, and of the priests, and the Levites, and the singers, and the porters, and the Nethinims, unto Jerusalem, in the seventh year of Artaxerxes the king.

Ezra 7:8 (KJV) — 8 And he came to Jerusalem in the fifth month, which was in the seventh year of the king.

Ezra 7:11 (KJV) — 11 Now this is the copy of the letter that the king Artaxerxes gave unto Ezra the priest, the scribe, even a scribe of the words of the commandments of the LORD, and of his statutes to Israel.


