Isaiah 21:5–6 (KJV) — 5 Prepare the table, watch
in the watchtower, eat, drink: arise, ye princes, and
anoint the shield. 6 For thus hath the Lord said
unto me, Go, set a watchman, let him declare what
he seeth.

Isaiah 21:7-9 (KJV) — 7 And he saw a chariot with a couple of horsemen, a chariot of asses, and a chariot of camels; and he hearkened diligently with much heed:
8 And he cried, A lion: My lord, I stand continually upon the watchtower in the daytime, and I am set in my ward whole nights:
9 And, behold, here cometh a chariot of men, with a couple of horsemen. And he answered and said, Babylon is fallen, is fallen; and all the graven images of her gods he hath broken unto the ground.





Jeremiah 51:7-9 (KJV) — 7 Babylon hath been a golden cup in the LORD'S hand, that made all the earth drunken: the nations have drunken of her wine; therefore the nations are mad. 8 Babylon is suddenly fallen and destroyed: howl for her; take balm for her pain, if so be she may be healed. 9 We would have healed Babylon, but she is not healed: forsake her, and let us go every one into his own country: for her judgment reacheth unto heaven, and is lifted up even to the skies.

**Revelation 17:5 (KJV) — 5 And upon her forehead
was a name written, MYSTERY, BABYLON THE
GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND
ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH.**

2 Corinthians 11:2 (KJV) — 2 For I am jealous over you with godly jealousy: for I have espoused you to one husband, that I may present you as a chaste virgin to Christ.

2 Thessalonians 2:9–12 (KJV) — 9 Even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders, 10 And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved. 11 And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie: 12 That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness.

Genesis 12:1-4 (KJV) — 1 Now the LORD had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee: 2 And I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing: 3 And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed. 4 So Abram departed, as the LORD had spoken unto him; and Lot went with him: and Abram was seventy and five years old when he departed out of Haran.

In this call, there were three distinct parts.

- Abraham was to leave his country,
- his kindred,
- and his father's house.

Genesis 13:14–15 (KJV) — 14 And the LORD said unto Abram, after that Lot was separated from him, Lift up now thine eyes, and look from the place where thou art northward, and southward, and eastward, and westward: 15 For all the land which thou seest, to thee will I give it, and to thy seed for ever.

1 Peter 1:15–16 (KJV) — 15 But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation; 16 Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy. (See Leviticus 20:7)

Numbers 23:9 (KJV) — 9 For from the top of the
rocks I see him, and from the hills I behold him: lo,
the people shall dwell alone, and shall not be reckoned
among the nations.

2 Corinthians 6:14–16 (KJV) — 14 Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness? 15 And what concord hath Christ with Belial? or what part hath he that believeth with an infidel? 16 And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? for ye are the temple of the living God; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

2 Corinthians 6:17-18 (KJV) — 17 Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you, 18 And will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty.

2 Timothy 3:1-4 (KJV) — 1 This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come. 2 For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, 3 Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good, 4 Traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God;

2 Timothy 3:5 (KJV) — 5 Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away.

Isaiah 9:16 (KJV) — 16 For the leaders of this people cause them to err; and they that are led of them are destroyed.

Jeremiah 50:6 (KJV) — 6 My people hath been lost sheep:
their shepherds have caused them to go astray, they have
turned them away on the mountains: they have gone from
mountain to hill, they have forgotten their restingplace.

Ezekiel 14:20 (KJV) — 20 Though Noah, Daniel, and Job, were in it, as I live, saith the Lord GOD, they shall deliver neither son nor daughter; they shall but deliver their own souls by their righteousness.

Hosea 4:6 (KJV) — 6 My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, . . .

2 Peter 1:2–3 (KJV) — 2 Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord, 3 According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:
