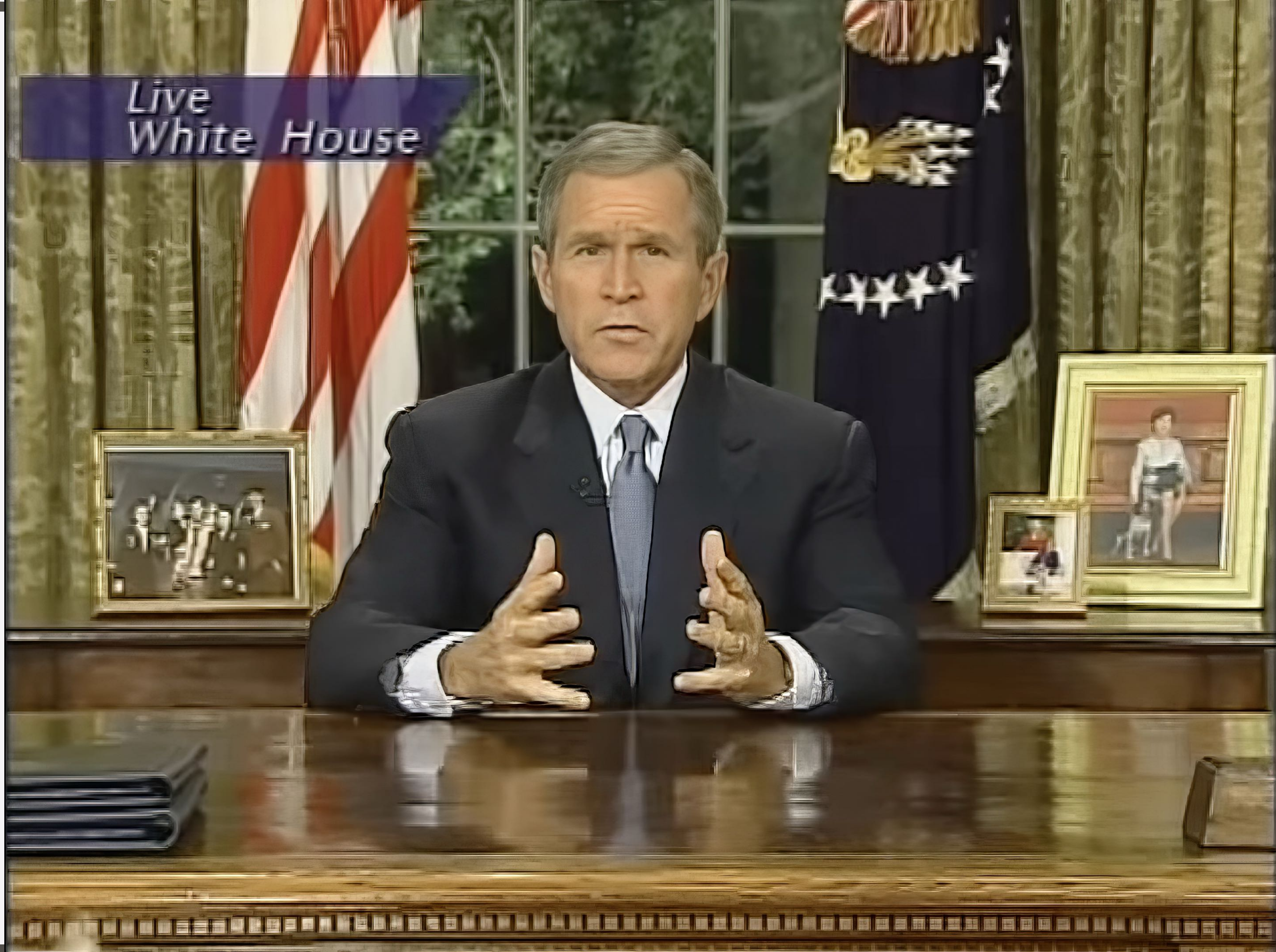

**Luke 2:49 (KJV)** — 49 And he said unto them, How is it that ye sought me? wist ye not that **I must be** about my Father's business?

**Luke 9:51 (KJV)** — 51 And it came to pass, when the time was come that he should be received up, he stedfastly set his face to go to Jerusalem,

His steps are turned toward Jerusalem, where His foes have long plotted to take His life; now He will lay it down. He set His face steadfastly to go to persecution, denial, rejection, condemnation, and death. (*The Desire of Ages*, p. 486.2)

**Matthew 26:38 (KJV)** — 38 Then saith he unto them, My soul is exceeding sorrowful, even unto death: . . .

**Matthew 26:39 (KJV)** — 39 . . . O my Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me: nevertheless not as I will, but as thou wilt.

**Matthew 26:53 (KJV)** — 53 Thinkest thou that I cannot now pray  
to my Father, and he shall presently give me more than twelve  
legions of angels?

**Daniel 1:8 (KJV)** — 8 But Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself with the portion of the king's meat, nor with the wine which he drank: therefore he requested of the prince of the eunuchs that he might not defile himself.
